Committee on Air Pollution Effects Research on Mediterranean Ecosystems

Mediterranean ecosystems are coping with multiple stresses due to the ongoing climate change processes. The impacts on their stability should be better understood to develop suitable adaptation and mitigation strategies, both for managed and natural ecosystems. CAPERmed aims to bring together people working on air pollution in Mediterranean ecosystems in order to coordinate expertise for quantifying current impacts and identifying future challenges.

The 2nd edition of the CAPERmed meeting will bring together scientists and stakeholders from the Mediterranean basin specifically interested in the effects of air pollution and climate change on Mediterranean ecosystems to share innovative ideas and research methodologies for a more sustainable future. Main aim of the meeting is to set the basis of a proposal for a common funded research project.

The meeting will take place in Brescia, Italy, on the 28th-30th June 2016 and will be hosted by Giacomo Gerosa, Riccardo Marzuoli and Angelo Finco.
