HOW TO REACH THE WORKSHOP VENUE AT THE CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY

Directions to the Catholic University

From the railway station (Stazione Centrale F.S.), take the underground line 2 ("green line"), direction 'Assago' or 'Abbiategrasso'. The sixth stop is S. Ambrogio Station, get out of the underground and move towards the 'Basilica'. Leave the Basilica on your right and walk straight for about five minutes; on your right you will see the University main entrance (Gemelli Square, 1). The seminar room is in Gemelli Square, 1. In the building in Via (street) Necchi, 5 you can find Gianluca Femminis (fourth floor, pho. (39) 02 72343808) and Giulia Rivolta (fourth floor, pho. (39) 02 72343392). Via Necchi is on the left watching the university main entrance (see map-marked with a star).

From Orio al Serio Airport: take the Coach to the railway station Milano Centrale, then see above. (For information: <u>http://www.milanbergamoairport.it/en/</u>)

From Linate Airport: take Bus nr. 73 to S. Babila square, then take the underground line 1 ("red line") to Cadorna square (see below). Taking a taxicab is a sensible option.

From Cadorna square: walk down via (street) Carducci. This is on the right from the middle of Cadorna square. In about five minutes your reach an important crossroad: on the right you should see Monti Street and Magenta Street. On your left, Magenta street goes on. Take Magenta Street on the left and in a few meters, you should notice a narrow street on the right. This is Terraggio street. Follow it walking for about five further minutes. On your left you will see the University main entrance (Gemelli Square, nr. 1). Via Necchi in on the left watching the university main entrance (see map - marked with a star).

From Malpensa Airport: take the railway shuttle to Cadorna Station, <u>http://www.malpensaexpress.it/en/</u> then see above.

Directions to the 'Bontadini' Room (Workshop Venue)

The workshop is held in the 'Bontadini' Room, an underground Room.

To reach the room, go through the main entrance, and go straight until you reach the cloister. Turn right; at the beginning of the second cloister turn left and walk to the opposite corner of the cloister. Turn right again; when you reach the middle of the second cloister you find a door. Passing through it, you find yourself in a backyard. Cross it (a few metres) and you find the staircase leading down to the Bontadini Room (also indicated as G001) - Please refer to the second map.
